Membership Rules and Regulations

It is the responsibility of all the Members, the Board of Directors and the Staff to follow the guidelines outlined towards the development and the betterment of the community and to manage the facilities in keeping with the philosophy outlined herein.

It is the duty of the membership to know these rules and to cooperate with management and staff in the enforcement of the rules to ensure a positive, fun and safe environment.

If a member or their guest(s) do not comply with the rules as adopted by the Board of Directors, disciplinary action including loss of membership and its privileges may occur.

General Rules

1. No person shall use the Arena or other facilities without holding a valid, current membership in the Society.
2. The schedule shall be published on the website and in the Arena. However, where a discrepancy occurs, the Master Booking calendar in the Office shall be deemed to be the correct schedule.
3. The Agriplex and Hebson Arenas are designated No Smoking facilities at all times.
4. All dogs brought into the facility must be on a leash at all times and under the control of the handler.
5. It is the responsibility of all users to ensure that all horse droppings are placed into the manure barrels upon completion of riding.
6. Horses must be tied in the horse parking area when not in use. Horses shall not be allowed to run loose in the arena.
7. All riders must sign in prior to using the facilities for Public Riding.

8. No children under the age of 12 years be allowed near the cattle handling or chute areas, both inside and outside, at any time. Children under 10 years are not allowed in the horse parking area without adult supervision.

9. Horse and cattle health must meet the standards necessary to ensure that all vaccinations are up to date to prevent diseases viruses and contaminants, proof is available, and any other communicable disease is not to be spread and that animals with known problems must be identified to the society and to other members.

10. Use of barrels, jumps and other devices is restricted. If the arena becomes occupied by other users, then the use of such items must stop unless permission is received from the other users.

11. Private lessons are not permitted without special permission from management.

12. Use of the facilities is at the riders own risk.

13. No parking of vehicles is allowed along the west roadway between the outdoor arena and the Agriplex. No parking is allowed along the south, east and west sides of the Hebson arena.

14. All Members are asked to abide by these rules and to deal with violators in a polite yet firm manner, referring disputes to Staff for final disposition.
